

## **DOCUMENTING MIGRAINES (G43)**

- In ICD-10-CM, migraines are classified to category G43, with 12 subcategories:
  - Migraine with or without aura
  - Hemiplegic migraine
  - Persistent migraine aura with or without cerebral infarction
  - Chronic migraine without aura
  - Cyclical vomiting
  - Opthamoplegic migraine
  - Periodic headache syndromes in child or adult
  - Abdominal migraine
  - Other migraine
  - Migraine unspecified
- Migraines are differentiated as not intractable or intractable
- Migraines can also be identified as occurring with or without status migrainous
- Lower-half migraine and migrainous neuralgia are correlated to cluster headache syndrome
- Document conditions that may cause or be associated with migraines should be reported additionally;
  - Cerebral infarction
  - Migraine seizure
- For menstrual migraines, an additional code is required for associated premenstrual tension syndrome
