

Recent records indicate that you are receiving 835/ERA (Electronic Remittance Advice) through Capario (ProxyMed). As you may know, Change Health has assumed services previously provided by Capario (ProxyMed) and as of March 9, 2017, they have closed the 835/ERA connection. In order to continue to receive your 835/ERAs from MVP, you must establish a new valid connection.

To establish a new valid connection; contact MVP's EFT/ERA vendor **PaySpan**, refer to MVP's Preferred Clearing House vendor list at **mvphealthcare.com/providers/notifications-to-providers,** or set up a direct connection with MVP.
