MVP Health Care® will begin to look at <u>all</u> institutional claims and will begin to deny certain claims as of 2/28/17. Per 5010 guidelines, when an institutional claim is received without an admission type code it will be denied back to the provider. This is the CL101 segment on an institutional 837 claim.

ADMISSION SOURCE CODE

• The admission source code when submitted for all lines of business will be validated and confirmed that it's a valid code. An admission source code submission is required for institutional Medicare claims except for type of bill 14X. In cases where the member is not admitted, please submit admission source code 9.

- 1 Non-Health Care Facility Point of Origin (Physician Referral)
- 2 Clinic
- 4 Transfer from a Hospital (Different Facility)
